Instructions:

1. 8oz Beverage
 - a. Tap on drink of choice
 - b. Tap green 'Play' button
2. 12oz Beverage
 - a. Tap on 12oz size
 - b. Tap on drink of choice
 - c. Tap green 'Play' button
