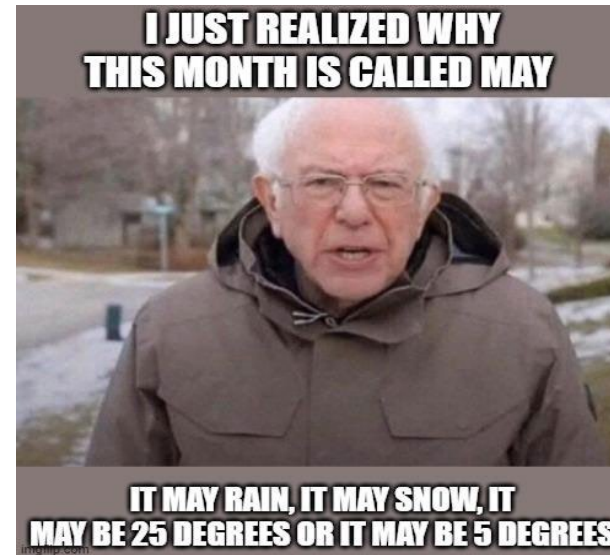

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know...?

Did you know the type of humidifier and water you use can affect the dust and white powder-y substance you are seeing in your suites?

Here is a summary of what we have found out:

Cool mist humidifiers

- Doesn't heat water → minerals stay in the mist
- Can leave **white dust** (mineral residue) on nearby surfaces
- More likely to cause **light powdery buildup** around the unit

Warm/heat humidifiers

- Boils the water → minerals stay behind in the tank
- **Little to no white dust** released into the air
- But can cause **yellowing/discoloration** over time if there's residue buildup or slight scorching inside the unit

Bottom line:

- Seeing white dust? → usually **cool mist + hard water**
- Seeing yellowing/staining? → more likely **warm mist residue or heat-related buildup**

Car Snoops

The snow is going away which means there are more opportunities to walk outside. This also means that many different types of foot traffic will walk by the building and, unfortunately, will peek into parked vehicles.

We are recommending for residents not to leave anything, especially of value, in vehicles. The Car Snoops will look in, see it, and potentially break windows to get what they want.

Also, please do not leave your registration in your vehicles – there are multiple scams that can come up from that piece of paper getting into the Car Snoops' hands. Instead, keep your registration in a purse or wallet that you plan to bring with you!
